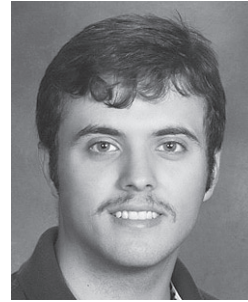


Dalton Quade Clinton

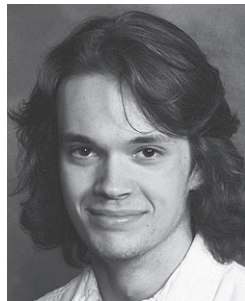

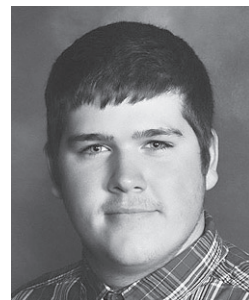
