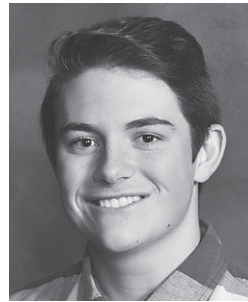


*Dylan Ryan Dohrn*

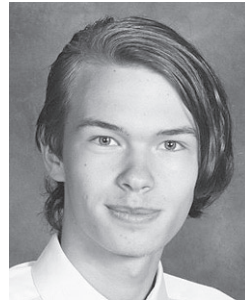

Anthony David Dowdell is a member of the Class of 2017.

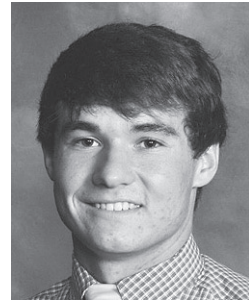
